The role of the hospital services planning tools

June 26-27 Venue: The World Bank office, Kyiv, Dniprovskyi uzviz, 1, room 148

In many countries employ health plans as major planning tools. In line with the various tiers of administration

involved in capacity planning, health plans are developed at national, regional and/or local level.

In most countries, health care capacity planning takes place at national, regional or local level, reflecting the various tiers of government within health systems, but the distinction between these levels is not always clear cut.

Conceptually, planning is associated with two different functions: strategic planning and operational planning.

Organized workshop will represent a process towards evidence based policy approach to define a long-term planning perspective for key resources in the Ukrainian health system.

Excess capacity in terms of infrastructure, equipment, and staff represents a costly burden on any healthcare system and optimizing the capacity can result in savings for the system, improvements in quality, and improved access and satisfaction for the population.

The main discussions during the workshop will be based on how could estimating long-term needs for services and setting the level of supply based on these needs and the expected demographic and epidemiological changes be implemented for two Oblasts in Ukraine.
